Professional Efficiency Development (PED)

1. *Introduction.*— Students are deputed to Maharashtra State for B.V.Sc. & A.H. Degree Course as there is no Veterinary College in Goa.

2. *Objective of the Scheme.*— In the past, students seeking admission to Veterinary Degree Course had to depend on the seats allotted by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research. Since 1996-97 the students are to be admitted within the regulations prescribed by the Veterinary Council of India.

Till 2020-21, 05 Nos. of students were being sent to Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Veterinary Education and Research, Puducherry. As their fees are exorbitant, the seats have been discontinued and added 05 seats to Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University (MAFSU) with due approval of Veterinary Council of India and Government of India. The total number of seat at MAFSU has been raised from 06 to 11.

3. *Scope of the Scheme.*— There is a great scope for Animal Husbandry activities, employment opportunities and self employment.

4. *Eligibility.*— (1) Domicile of 15 years or 15 years Residence Certificate issued by Mamlatdar.

(2) The Applicant should have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate (Std. XIIth) examination of the Goa Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination and secured not less than 50% marks in the aggregate of subjects of Physics, Chemistry & Biology 47.5% for the applicants belonging to SC, ST & OBC for admission to MAFSU.

(3) Subject to fulfillment of all the above, candidate desirous of taking up the course would be sponsored as the availability of seats and observation of reservation criteria (i.e. OBC-27%, ST-12%, SC-2% and EWS-10%).

(4) Selection of candidates through Directorate of Technical Education, Government of Goa, on the basis of merit of “NEET” for MAFSU.

(5) If Reserved Seats for SC/ST/OBC/EWS are not filled then the same will be filled by the General Category.

(6) Support fees of the candidates selected @ Rs. 75,000/- per student per year as per merit will be borne by the Government.

(7) Submit Agreement Bond duly signed on a prescribed stamp paper, for compliance of conditions as prescribed by the Government for obtaining the benefits of the support fees.

(8) Affidavit-cum-Bond of Rs. 3,75,000/- (Rupees Three lakhs seventy five thousand only) to be furnished on selection.

(9) SC/ST candidates besides availing Support Fees from Department, can also avail benefit from the Directorate of Tribal Welfare.

(10) Candidate should compulsorily serve the State Government in rural areas on a stipend basis for minimum period of one year upon completion of the course. Stipend amount as may be prescribed by the Government at the relevant time for which there shall be no relaxation. This is after completion of the Degree Course P. G. Course.

5. *Quantum of Financial Assistance Scheme.*— This Scheme is aimed at providing of financial assistance in the form of support fees to the 11 (eleven) or more selected students in the form of Support Fees for undergoing B.V. Sc. & A.H. Degree Course at Maharashtra and such other State so included hereinafter amounting to Rs. 75,000/- per student per year for 05 years.

This support fee may vary from any Academic Year as per their governing body decision wherein approval is taken from the Government from time to time.

6. *Pattern of Assistance.*— The Government of Goa will provide Financial Assistance to the eligible and sponsored candidates in form of a support fee of Rs. 75,000/- per student per year for 5 years i.e. Rs. 3,75,000/- for MAFSU and such other State included hereinafter. The Assistance shall also be extended to such other eligible candidates as determined to be deputed for the other States so decided by the Government from time to time.

7. *Relaxation of the provision of the scheme.*— Government may also revise any of the clauses as felt deemed fit necessary from time to time.

8. *Interpretation of the provision of the scheme.*— The proposed scheme with fund availability will benefit 11 (eleven) students every year at present as per the reservation criteria as mentioned above and such other State so included hereinafter.

Whereas, the Goa Government/Directorate of Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services has signed an MOU with Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University (MAFSU), Nagpur (Maharashtra) for allotment of 11 seats annually at these University, since Goa does not have a Veterinary College.

And whereas, the MAFSU is conducting the Bachelor of Veterinary Science & Animal Husbandry (B.V.Sc. & A.H.) Degree Course (hereinafter referred to as the "said Course of Study"); and has reserved 05 seats at Mumbai Veterinary College, Mumbai, 04 seats at Krantisinh Nana Patil College of Veterinary Science at Shirwal and 02 seats at College of Veterinary & Animal Science, Parbhani for Goa domiciled students.

And whereas, the Bounden had submitted his/ her application for the course of B.V.Sc. & A.H. (hereinafter referred to as the "said Course of Study") to the Directorate of Technical Education being appointed as the Nodal body for conducting admissions to all professional courses in State of Goa;

And whereas, the Bounden has been selected to the said Course of Study on the basis of merit of the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET)-UG Entrance Examination for the Academic Year 2023-24.

And whereas, in terms of Order the candidate admitted to the said Course of Study is required to execute a Bond as per the terms and conditions stipulated therein.

Now therefore, the condition of the above written Bond is that:—

In the event of the Bounden:— (a) refusing/failing to serve the Government for a period of one year on completion of the said course of study (even after the completion of the Degree Course/PG Course), if called upon by the Government within a period of six months from the date of his/her completion of the said Course of Study;

(b) refusing/failing to submit himself/herself to any order of the Government or of any office/authority under whom he/she may, from time to time, be placed by the Government;

(c) not maintaining discipline, decorum and/or a suitable standard of conduct during the period of the said Course of Study and/or whilst rendering service to the Government for such period of one year after completion of the said Course of Study;

(d) abandoning/discontinuing the said Course of Study without prior written approval of the Government;

(e) refusing/failing to comply with any instruction/order/direction issued by the Government or of its authorized officers;

(f) committing breach of any of the terms and conditions stipulated in the Agreement dated _____ executed by the Bounden with the Government, the admission of service of the Bounden shall be liable to be cancelled or terminated, as the case may be, and the Bounden shall forthwith pay to the Government, on demand, a sum of Rs. 3,75,000/- (Rupees Three lakhs seventy five thousand only) without prejudice to any other action that the Government may take against the Bounden.

Any such demand made (a to f) on the Bounden shall be conclusive as regards the amount due and payable by the Bounden under this Bond and the Bounden shall pay to the Government the amount as specified, immediately without any delay. Upon failure on part of Bounden to make such payments this Bond, the Surety shall be liable to make such payments to the Government the amount specified therein within the stipulated time as directed by the Government.

AGREEMENT

This agreement is made on this _____ day of _____ Two Thousand Twenty Three Year between the Governor of Goa (hereinafter called the "Government") of the ONE PART and Shri/Kum. _____ major in age, _____ years son/daughter of resident of _____ (hereinafter called the 'Trainee') which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof include his/her heirs, legal representatives, executors and

administrators of the SECOND PART and Shri/Smt. _____ major in age, resident of _____ (hereinafter called the 'Surety') which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning therefore includes his/her heirs, legal representatives, executors and administrators of the THIRD PART.

Whereas, the Government of Goa has requested the _____ for reservation of seats for students from the State of Goa in Bachelor in Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry (hereinafter called the 'Degree/Course') at the (hereinafter called the 'Institute');

And whereas, the Trainee has availed the reserved seat for the students from the Goa Government Quota for which support fee of Rs. 3,75,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Seventy Five Thousand Only) is agreed to be paid to the Institute by the Government;

And whereas, the Trainee has given an undertaking to observe the conditions stipulated in pattern of assistance governing payment of support fees of Rs. 3,75,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Seventy Five Thousand Only) which is appended herewith, and has deposited an amount of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only) by way of demand draft bearing No. _____ dated _____ drawn in favour of the Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services, Panaji-Goa.

And whereas the Government has agreed to pay the said support fee of Rs. 3,75,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Seventy Five Thousand Only) to the said Institute subject to the Trainee agreeing to certain terms and conditions hereinafter appearing.

Now, therefore this agreement witnesses the parties hereto mutually agree as follows:—

1) That, in consideration of the Government granting under letter No. _____ dated _____ to the Trainee a support fee of Rs. 3,75,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Seventy Five Thousand Only) leading to the (B.V.Sc. & A.H.) Bachelor of Veterinary Sciences and Animal Husbandry in the said Institute, the Trainee covenant with the Government that he/she shall compulsorily serve the Government of Goa in rural areas after successful completion of said Graduation/Post Graduation course for a minimum period of one year in such post (contract, ad-hoc/permanent) as may be assigned to him/her by the

Government and on such terms and conditions as the Government may fix as per the availability of the post. In such case, if no such appointment order is given to the Trainee before the expiry of twenty four months from the date of reporting the completion of said degree course the trainee and the surety shall be deemed to have absolved of all responsibilities, liabilities duties cast upon him/her under this clause.

2) The Trainee, thus admitted in the said Institute shall be governed by all the rules and regulations of the said Institute.

3) Failure on the part of the Trainee to pursue his/her studies upto culmination of his/her obtaining a degree in Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry, the trainee shall repay Rs. 3,75,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Seventy Five Thousand Only) alongwith 18% interest per annum, to the Government from the date of disbursement of the said support fee and the trainee and surety shall be jointly and severally responsible for the payment of the same to the Government.

4) The Trainee and the Surety shall be jointly and severally responsible to pay additional support fee to the said Institute in case trainee takes more than the period stipulated by the Institute to complete his/her said Graduation Course.

5) The Trainee and the Surety shall after successful completion of said degree course and publication of the final results within a month, report to the Director of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services of the Government of Goa at Panaji and inform the fact of the completion of his/her studies by submitting copy of Passing Certificate. On successful completion of the said degree/course within the stipulated time an amount of Rs. 5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only) deposited by the Trainee shall be refunded to the Trainee and no interest will be paid on this deposit. In case Trainee fails to complete the course or leave the course in between Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only) deposited by Trainee shall be forfeited.

6) The TRAINEE and the SURETY shall be jointly and severally responsible for the payment of any further amounts that may be granted to the TRAINEE/INSTITUTION (wherein admission is sought) by the Government, with such interest thereon not exceeding 18% per annum.

7) Granting of any time by the Government to pay the whole or part of the amount due to the Government from the Trainee shall not absolve the Trainee and the Surety of their liabilities under the Agreement.

The Government shall recover all dues from Parent/Surety/Trainee under this Agreement as an arrears of land revenue.

The stamp duty on this Agreement shall be borne by the Trainee.

“1 (i) This scheme shall be called ‘Mukhyamantri Purabhilekh Prakashan Yojana’.”

Whereas, the use of Aadhaar as an identity document for delivery of services or benefits or subsidies simplifies the Government

delivery processes, brings in transparency and efficiency, and enables beneficiaries to get their entitlements directly in a convenient and seamless manner by obviating the need to produce multiple documents to prove one's identity;

And whereas, the Directorate of Higher Education, Porvorim-Goa (hereinafter referred to as the Department) is administering the "Sant Sohrobanath Ambiye Dnyanvrudhi Shishyavrutti" (Bursary Scheme) (hereinafter referred to as the Scheme) to universalize Higher and Technical Education in the State, thereby raising the Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) to around 45 from the present 33.8. The scheme envisages to enable students to pursue Higher and Professional Education including post-graduation in the State of Goa whose annual income of both parent(s)/guardian taken together is less than Rupees three lakhs. With this sole objective in mind, scheme for the grant of financial assistance towards the fees paid for various courses under Higher and Technical Education has been formulated which is being implemented by Goa Education Development Corporation (GEDC) (hereinafter referred to as the Implementing Agency) through the Directorate of Higher Education, Porvorim-Goa.

And whereas, under the scheme, the maximum amount of grants shall be restricted to Rs. 40,000/- per annum and also only for those cases where the total course/programme fees do not exceed Rs. 60,000/- per annum shall be considered under this scheme (hereinafter referred to as the benefits) is given to the:

(i) The students (hereinafter referred to as the beneficiaries) pursuing College (Higher and Professional) Education in the State of Goa including post graduation shall be eligible to receive the benefits under the scheme, provided they meet the eligibility criteria laid down in scheme.

(ii) The actual grant would be calculated on the basis of the fees paid for each of the course/program and will be limited to the

payment to fees and other charges given to the Colleges/Institution.

(iii) The concerned beneficiaries shall pay the requisite fees for the course that he/she pursues. The eligible quantum of fees shall be reimbursed to him through direct transfer to his Bank Account.

(iv) The beneficiaries who have completed his Xth and XIIth and graduation in case of post graduation students from an institution in Goa. For benefits under the scheme, in case of post graduation course, the requirement of graduate degree from college/university from Goa, will be relaxed for degree from Central University, NIT, IIT, IIM & other statutorily created institutions.

(v) The institutions where the beneficiaries pursues his studies should be affiliated to Goa University and recognized by Directorate of Higher Education/ Directorate of Technical Education, for the purpose of this scheme. However, the beneficiaries studying in Government of India institutions located in Goa conducting Higher or Technical Education courses/programmes, who are found eligible as per clause 3(4) above shall also be considered for availing benefit under the scheme by the Directorate of Higher Education as per the extant Scheme guidelines.

And whereas, the aforesaid scheme involves recurring expenditure incurred from the Consolidated fund of Government of Goa;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of Section 7 of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 (18 of 2016) (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), the Government of Goa hereby notifies the following, namely:—

1. (1) An individual eligible for receiving the benefits under the scheme shall hereby be required to furnish proof of possession of the Aadhaar number or undergo Aadhaar authentication.

(2) Any individual desirous of availing benefits under the scheme, who does not possess the Aadhaar number or, has not yet enrolled for Aadhaar, shall be required to make application for Aadhaar enrolment before registering for the scheme provided that he is entitled to obtain Aadhaar as per Section 3 of the said Act, and such individuals shall visit any Aadhaar enrolment Centre (list available at the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) website (www.uidai.gov.in) to get enrolled for Aadhaar.

(3) As per regulation 12 of the Aadhaar (Enrolment and Update) Regulations, 2016, the Department through its Implementing Agency, is required to offer Aadhaar enrolment facilities for the beneficiaries who are not yet enrolled for Aadhaar and in case there is no Aadhaar enrolment centre located in the respective Block or Taluka or Tehsil, the Department through its Implementing Agency shall provide Aadhaar enrolment facilities at convenient locations in coordination with the existing Registrars of UIDAI or by becoming a UIDAI Registrar themselves:

Provided that till the time Aadhaar is assigned to the individual, benefits under the scheme shall be given to such individual, subject to the production of the following documents, namely:—

(a) If he has enrolled, his Aadhaar Enrolment Identification slip; and

(b) Anyone of the following documents, namely;

i) Bank or Post Office Passbook with Photo; or

ii) Permanent Account Number (PAN) Card; or

iii) Passport; or

iv) Ration Card; or

v) Voter Identity Card; or

vi) MGNREGA Card; or

vii) Kisan Photo passbook; or

viii) Driving license issued by the Licensing Authority under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988); or

ix) Certificate of identity having photo of such person issued by a Gazetted Officer or a Tehsildar on an official letter head; or

x) Any other document as specified by the Department:

Provided further that the above documents may be checked by an officer specifically designated by the Department for that purpose.

2. In order to provide benefits to the beneficiaries under the scheme conveniently, the Department through its Implementing Agency shall make all the required arrangements to ensure that wide publicity through the media shall be given to the beneficiaries to make them aware of the said requirement.

3. In all cases, where Aadhaar authentication fails due to poor biometrics of the beneficiaries or due to any other reason, the following remedial mechanisms shall be adopted, namely:—

(a) in case of poor fingerprint quality, iris scan or facep authentication facility shall be adopted for authentication, thereby the Department through its Implementing Agency shall make provisions for iris scanners or face authentication along with finger-print authentication for delivery of benefits in seamless manner;

(b) in case the biometric authentication through fingerprints or iris scan or face authentication is not successful, wherever feasible and admissible authentication by Aadhaar One Time Password or Time-based One-Time Password with limited time validity, as the case may be, shall be offered;

(c) in all other cases where biometric or Aadhaar One Time Password or Time-based One-Time Password authentication is not possible, benefits under the scheme may

be given on the basis of physical Aadhaar letter whose authenticity can be verified through the Quick Response code printed on the Aadhaar letter and the necessary arrangement of Quick Response code reader shall be provided at the convenient locations by the Department through its, Implementing Agency.

4. In addition to the above, in order to ensure that no bonafide beneficiary under the Scheme is deprived of his due benefits, the Department through its Implementing Agency shall follow the exception handling mechanism as outlined in the Office Memorandum of DBT Mission, Cabinet Secretariat, Government of India dated 19th December, 2017.

5. This notification shall come into effect from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

And whereas, the Directorate of Higher Education, Porvorim-Goa (hereinafter referred to as the Department) is administering the Manohar Parrikar Goa Scholar Scheme (hereinafter referred to as the Scheme)

to give financial support for talented brilliant students, who needs to be encouraged and empowered to take up Post Graduate/ /Doctoral courses in reputed institutions in India and abroad which is being implemented through the Directorate of Higher Education, Porvorim-Goa at the State Level (hereinafter referred to as the Implementing Agency);

And whereas, under the scheme, 20 outstanding Scholars every year shall be selected and awarded the scholarship amounting Rs. 8,00,000/- lakh for pursuing studies in India or USD 25,000/- for studies in abroad and an appreciation certificate. (hereinafter referred to as the benefits) is given to the i) The applicant who have passed the qualifying degree examination from an institution preferably located in Goa and also from institutions located in any other parts of India. ii) The applicant must have scored minimum of 60% marks or equivalent grade in the qualifying degree examination along with minimum 70% aggregate marks. iii) The applicant must have obtained confirmed admission during the period of the Scholarship. iv) The applicant shall pursue post graduate or doctoral courses in any discipline (hereinafter referred to as the beneficiaries) by the Directorate of Higher Education, Porvorim-Goa as per the extant scheme guidelines;

And whereas, the aforesaid scheme involves recurring expenditure incurred from the consolidated fund of Government of Goa;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of Section 7 of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 (18 of 2016) (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), the Government of Goa hereby notifies the following, namely:—

Government of Goa is pleased to notify the “Mukhyamantri Modified Interest Rebate Scheme (MMIRS)”. The Scheme shall be operated and managed by EDC Limited. The Scheme shall be effective from 01-04-2023 to 31-03-2028.

Mukhyamantri Modified Interest Rebate Scheme (MMIRS)

Introduction.— In order to encourage investments in various sectors, Government of Goa has decided to promote Industrial development in the State, not only concentrated in the coastal and central areas of the State, but also in the backward talukas. In order to encourage entrepreneurs to set up their units in the industrially backward talukas, the Government of Goa has modified the earlier “Modified Interest Rebate Scheme-2012” thereby making it more attractive and is now pleased to launch the new scheme called “Mukhyamantri Modified Interest Rebate Scheme”.

Government is hopeful that this interest rebate scheme would give a major boost to industrialization in the State apart from encouraging locals, women entrepreneurs and employment of Goans in industry.

Salient Features of the Scheme

Duration of Scheme: 5 years (From 01-04-2023 to 31-03-2028).

Eligibility Norms: For new as well as existing industrial/MSME loans disbursed by EDC, except units set up in sectors listed in Negative List.

Categories under the Scheme

A. Units located in backward Talukas of Goa:

(i) Eligibility	Units located in the Talukas of Pernem, Sattari, Sanguem, Quepem, Canacona, Bicholim and Dharbandora.
(ii) Quantum of rebate	5% p.a.

B. Units promoted by Resident/Non-Resident Goan Entrepreneurs:

(i) Eligibility	The units promoted by the resident/non resident Goan Entrepreneurs. These will include the following categories: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Native Goans. • Promoters who are resident of Goa for not less than last 15 years. • Persons of Goan Origin (PGOs), Non Resident Goans (NRGs) etc. • In case of partnerships and limited companies, the effective shareholding of the resident/non-resident Goan Entrepreneurs and/or share holding of the resident/non resident Goan Entrepreneurs in other share holder entity/ies if any, shall not be less than 74% of the total paid up capital.
(ii) Quantum of rebate	2% p.a.

C. Units promoted by Women Entrepreneurs:

(i) Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The units promoted by the Women Entrepreneurs. • The effective shareholding of the women entrepreneurs in the partnership/limited company and/or share holding of the women entrepreneur in other shareholder entity/ies if any, should not be less than 74% of the total paid up capital.
(ii) Quantum of rebate	2% p.a.

D. Units employing 20 or more Goan employees:

(i) Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The unit should employ 20 or more Goan employees. • Regular Goan employee is any employee who appears on the payroll of the unit for the entire claim year and has a 15 years residence proof.
(ii) Quantum of rebate	2% p.a.

QUANTUM OF REBATE: The maximum interest rebate shall be 9% p.a. The interest rebate under category A+B+C shall be capped to maximum of 7% p.a. and 2% p.a interest rebate is exclusively earmarked for category D. The total interest rebate shall not exceed Rs. 25.00 lakhs per annum per unit.

ENTITLEMENT OF REBATE

1. The units can get interest rebate in anyone of the above categories and also additional interest rebate under other categories, simultaneously.

2. The unit should have their loan account classified under standard category at the end of the financial year.

3. The units which were eligible for Interest Rebate under the earlier Modified Interest Rebate Scheme (MIRS-2012) will be considered under the present scheme w.e.f. 01-04-2023. However, units set up in sectors listed in negative list shall not be eligible for interest rebate under this scheme.

4. Calculation of interest rebate shall be based on the interest on loan repaid by the borrower, as per the loan repayment schedule fixed at the time of sanction. In case the borrower has paid before the due date as indicated in the repayment schedule, then the date on which such repayment is made would be considered for calculation of interest rebate.

General Terms and Conditions

1. The unit will be entitled for interest rebate as indicated in the scheme, on the interest charged on the term loan, based on the credit rating of the borrower or as mentioned in the loan scheme.

2. New loans including takeover loans (Standard category), are eligible, provided the activity/sector is not included in the negative list. Working Capital Term loans would also be eligible under the scheme.

3. The rebate eligible will be adjusted towards the principal/interest outstanding/ payable by the borrower to EDC, in the subsequent financial year, subject to receipt of the same from the Government or if regular the same reimbursed to the unit.

4. The present interest rebate scheme shall not be applicable, if the unit/party is already availing interest subsidy/rebate benefit, under any Central or State Government Schemes.

5. In case the unit is found ineligible on account of misrepresentation/miscalculation, the amount of interest rebate released shall be repayable forthwith by the unit/party and shall become recoverable as arrears of Land Revenue.

6. EDC Limited shall frame the procedure and documentation for receiving the interest rebate claims from eligible beneficiaries. The claims shall be processed and placed before the Committee constituted by the EDC Limited for approval and onward submission to the Government for payment of interest rebate.

7. All other special and general terms and conditions as applicable for sanction of term loan by the Corporation shall be applicable.

8. EDC Limited shall decide on all matters for the eligibility, sanction and disbursement of interest rebate to eligible units in case of any ambiguity or difficulty in interpretation.
