ORDER:-

The Principal Secretary to Government, Industries and Commerce Department, Government of Telangana in his D.O. letter second read above has informed that the Government of India has issued further guidelines as part of Business Reform Action Plan-2019, for implementation of auto renewal system for registrations / licenses under certain Labour laws, in addition to the reforms already implemented.

In the circumstances reported by the Commissioner of Labour, Telangana, 2. Hyderabad in his letter 3rd read above, Government after careful examination of the matter hereby decided to grant exemption from the applicability of sub-section (3) of section 13 of the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act. 1970 (Central Act 37 of 1970) and sub-rules (1) and (2) of Rule 29 of the Telangana Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Rules, 1971 issued in G.O.Ms.No.1313, Home (Labour-5) Department, dated: 09.09.1971, in order to implement Automatic non discretionary deemed renewal of license through online system, without the requirement of filing of application for renewal, subject to payment of fee prescribed by the Government from time to time, within the time prescribed, until further orders.

3. Accordingly, the following notification will be published in the Extraordinary issue of the Telangana State Gazette dated: 21.09.2020:

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred under section 31 of the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970 (Central Act 37 of 1970) as amended in the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) (Telangana Amendment) Act, 2003 (Act No.10 of 2003), the Government of Telangana hereby grant exemption from the applicability of sub-section (3) of section 13 of the said Act and sub-rules (1) and (2) of Rule 29 of the Telangana Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Rules, 1971 issued in G.O.Ms.No.1313, Home (Labour-5) Department, dated: 09.09.1971, in order to implement **Automatic non discretionary deemed renewal of license through online system**, without the requirement of filing of application for renewal, subject to payment of fee prescribed by the Government from time to time, within the time prescribed, until further orders.
